

ORDINANCE NO. 598

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF JEFFERSON, IOWA, 2017, BY AMENDING SECTION 106.05 TO PROVIDE FOR FREE DUMPSTER IN LIEU OF SPRING & FALL FREE CLEANUPS

Be it enacted by the City Council of Jefferson, Iowa:

SECTION 1. Section Amended. Section 106.05 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Jefferson, Iowa, 2017, is repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof:


106.05 BULKY RUBBISH. Bulky rubbish which is too large or heavy to be collected in the normal manner of other solid waste shall be collected by the City in accordance with the following procedures:

1. The City will provide a 4 cubic yard dumpster to each owner of a dwelling unit that is a residential premises once each year for a one week period to be used for a one time collection of bulky rubbish described above from such residential premises. Owners may arrange for the delivery of such dumpster on a first come first served basis by contacting the Office of the Clerk. This service will be provided only to customers with accounts in good standing with the City of Jefferson, and the service is not available to commercial customers. The dumpster may not be used for special items for which there are special charges under this Chapter.
2. Persons desiring to have bulky rubbish picked up at times other than when the free dumpster is provided must make prior arrangements with the sanitation department or the office of the Clerk for the collection of the same. Collection of such items will be billed on a per-collection and per-item basis.
3. Persons conducting construction or remodeling projects on their premises which will generate construction debris and materials exceeding the amount that can normally be picked up at regularly scheduled times shall make prior arrangements with the sanitation department or the office of the Clerk for the collection of the same. The sanitation department may in such cases either require the person to temporarily rent a dumpster, in which case the dumpster rental fees and pick up charges provided for in this chapter shall be billed, or if the scope of the project is determined by the sanitation department, in its sole discretion, to be too large, it may require such person to obtain the services of a commercial sanitation or refuse hauler for the removal of the same.

SECTION 2. Severability. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 3. When effective. This ordinance shall be effective as of the beginning of the monthly water and sewer billing cycle that commences immediately after this ordinance is published as required by law.
