ORDINANCE NO. <u>602</u> AN ORDINANCE CHANGING ZONING CLASSIFICATION FOR PROPERTY AT 504 & 506 EAST CLARK STREET

WHEREAS, pursuant to an application for zoning change made by the City of Jefferson for the property described below the Planning and Zoning Commission has recommended to the City Council that the zoning district classification for the property described below be changed from Light Industrial (LI) District to Residential Single Family – 6 (RS-6) District under the Jefferson Zoning Regulations; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing on this proposed zoning amendment was held at the regularly scheduled City Council meeting on May 11, 2021, pursuant to notice given in the manner required by law; and

WHEREAS, the City Council feels that it is in the best interests of the City of Jefferson that this zoning change be made.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Jefferson, Iowa, as follows:

SECTION 1. Amendment. The zoning classification for the following described property:

Lots 1, 2 & 3, Potter's Subdivision of Outlot 1, Manning's Addition to the City of Jefferson, Greene County, Iowa,

located at 504 & 506 East Clark Street in Jefferson, is changed from Light Industrial (LI) District to Residential Single Family – 6 (RS-6) District.

SECTION 2. Repealer. Any and all resolutions and ordinances, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. Severability. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 4. When effective. This ordinance shall be in effect after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
