ORDINANCE NO. 518

AN ORDINANCE VACATING ALLEY LOCATED IN BLOCK 8 IN LINCOLN PLACE ADDITION TO JEFFERSON

WHEREAS, by resolution adopted by the City Council of Jefferson on May 25, 2010, it was proposed that the alley described below be vacated; and

WHEREAS, notice of a public hearing on this proposal has been published as required by law; and

WHEREAS, that public hearing has been held at the time and place as specified in the notice and any and all objections or other comments relating to that proposal have been heard; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed to be in the best interests of the City of Jefferson, Iowa, that such alley be vacated as proposed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF JEFFERSON, IOWA, as follows:

Section 1. Vacation. The following described alley be and it is hereby vacated:

All of the east-west alley located in Block Eight (8) in Lincoln Place Addition to the City of Jefferson, Greene County, Iowa.

Section 2. Easements. This vacation is subject to all existing franchises, easements, licenses and permits, whether or not of record, and there shall be reserved unto the City of Jefferson and its franchisees an easement for purposes of the presences, operation, maintenance, repair and replacement of all existing utilities over, under and through such alley, with right of entry for servicing the same.

- Section 3. Repealer. Any and all resolutions and ordinances, or parts thereof, in conflict with this ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.
- Section 4. Severability clause. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.
- Section 5. When effective. This ordinance shall be in effect after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
