ORDINANCE NO. 529

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF JEFFERSON, IOWA, 2008, BY AMENDING PROVISIONS PERTAINING TO TRUCK, RECREATIONAL VEHICLE AND TRAILER PARKING

Be it enacted by the City Council of Jefferson, Iowa:

SECTION 1. Section Modified. Section 69.09 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Jefferson, Iowa, 2008, is repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof.

69.09 TRUCK, RECREATIONAL VEHICLE, TRAILER PARKING.

- 1. Residential Areas. No person shall park any motor truck carrier, van, stock truck, grain truck or straight truck, truck tractor, semi trailer or bus with a gross weight over five tons or over twenty feet in length, or any recreational vehicle or trailer of any kind on any street or within the parking area (between the curb or street edge and property line), including on a driveway within a parking area, within a residential area for a period exceeding two hours. If parked during nighttime hours, parking lights shall be left lighted.
- 2. Specified Areas. No person shall park any truck having a rated capacity of more than three-fourths ton on any street where angle parking is designated except for loading or unloading purposes.
- SECTION 2. Severability. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 3. When effective. This ordinance shall be in effect after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
