

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING ZONING CLASSIFICATION FOR
PROPERTY AT NORTH OLIVE STREET

WHEREAS, pursuant to an application for zoning change made by the owner of the property described below the Planning and Zoning Commission has recommended to the City Council that the zoning district classification for the property described below be changed from RS-6 (Residential Single Family District) to RM-3 (Residential Multi-Family District) under the Jefferson Zoning Regulations; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing on this proposed zoning amendment was held at the regularly scheduled City Council meeting on July 23, 2019, pursuant to notice given in the manner required by law; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that it is in the best interests of the City of Jefferson that this zoning change be made.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Jefferson, Iowa, as follows:

SECTION 1. Amendment. The zoning classification for the following described property:

Lots 6, 7, 8, 9, and 10, in Block 14 of the Subdivision of Block 9 in Manning's Addition to Jefferson, Greene County, Iowa,


located on the east side of the 500 block of North Olive Street in Jefferson, Iowa, is changed from RS-6 (Residential Single Family District) to RM-3 (Residential Multi-Family District).

SECTION 2. Repealer. Any all resolutions and ordinances, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. Severability. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 4. When effective. This ordinance shall be in effect after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

Finally passed by the Council and approved on July 23, 2019.


