<u>Street Closures</u>: The Water, Sewer, Streets Committee recommends the approval of requested street closures:

<u>Jefferson Matters</u>: around the Square for CyHawk Tailgate, September 4th as shown on the enclosed map.

<u>Journey Financial</u>: north half of the 100 block of Chestnut for their Open House on September 23rd.

<u>Thomas Laehn:</u> a portion of the 300 block of S.Maple for a get-together on Sept. 6th.

<u>Sewer Forgiveness</u>: The Water, Sewer, Streets Committee recommends forgiveness of sewer charges consistent with the forgiveness policy for 1310 Westwood Drive #4 in the amount of \$871.98, and the Children's Center, 306 S. Vine Street, for \$11,067.37. The Children's Center leak occurred over three months.

Internal TIF Debt: In order to receive TIF revenues, the City must certify TIF debt. One way to certify debt is through Internal Debt. Enclosed is a resolution proposing to "borrow" \$1.8 million from the Water Plant Construction Project. The current balance of the Water Plant Construction Fund is \$2.82 million. This debt will be repaid over six years, prior to the anticipated construction date for the water plant updates, shown in the CIP as 2034-35. The funds will continue to accrue investment interest for the Water Plant Construction Fund.

The \$1.8 million internal debt will be used for:

- \$300,000 forgivable loan to financially support the LMI units only in the Middle School housing project
- \$100,000 annually for five years to fund administrative activities needed for economic development in the Urban Renewal Area.
- \$120,000 annually for five years to fund Economic Development organizations.
- \$400,000 to be used for other projects listed in the Urban Renewal Plan.

Internal TIF Debt from Blight District: There will be a separate internal debt issuance of \$75,000 to be repaid using revenues from the newly created Blight TIF District. These funds will also be borrowed from the Water Plant Construction Fund and will be repaid over five years. The \$75,000 internal debt will be used to fund administrative activities needed for economic development and to fund Economic Development organizations.

<u>Rec Center AC</u>: Three large roof-mounted AC units serve the gym & fitness area in the Rec Center. Two of these unit are failing and are recommended for replacement. As the third unit was also installed around the same time and it requires a crane to lift the units into place, it is proposed that all three units be replaced.

Three bids were received. The low bid is \$79,467 from Moeller Furnace Company. This will be paid: \$20,000 contribution from the Hess Fund and the remainder from PACE funds.

<u>Easements</u>: Alliant Energy is requesting two small easements, one for the new transformer placed at the WWTP, and one for the transformer to be placed in Daubendiek Park for the new restroom. Documents describing the easements and a resolution approving the easements are enclosed.

GCDC: Greg Piklapp will present an update report for GCDC.

<u>WWTP Public Open House</u>: The City will hold an open house to celebrate the completion of the sewer plant project on *Friday*, *September 12th*. We will host a Java & Juice beginning at 9:30 a.m.. We will then have a ribbon cutting around 10:00 with small group tours of the plant to follow. Please plan to attend.

<u>Middle School Project</u>: The school will be open for tours Tuesday after the Council Meeting until 7:30. This is a great chance for City officials and staff to look at the construction progress being made.

Resolution Authorizing Internal Advance for Funding of Urban Renewal Projects in the Jefferson Urban Renewal Area

WHEREAS, the City of Jefferson, Iowa (the "City"), has previously established the Jefferson Urban Renewal Area (the "Urban Renewal Area") and has established the Jefferson Urban Renewal Area Tax Increment Revenue Fund (the "Tax Increment Fund") in connection therewith; and

WHEREAS, the City has authorized certain urban renewal projects (collectively, the "Projects") in the Urban Renewal Area consisting of (1) the Middle School Building Redevelopment Project; (2) the Parkland Development Project; (3) the Public Parking Lot Development Project; (4) the Jefferson Municipal Golf Course Improvements Project; (5) the Storm Water Drainage Improvements Project; (6) the Economic Development Demolition and Site Preparation Project (7) the Lincoln Way Economic Development Local Business Support Program; (8) the Urban Renewal Administration and Professional Support Program; (9) the 2027-2031 Greene County Development Corp. Support Program; and (10) the 2027-2031 Jefferson Matters-Main Street Support Program; and

WHEREAS, certain costs of the Projects have been or will be incurred in connection with the carrying out of such Projects; and

WHEREAS, in order to cover a portion of the costs of the Projects and to make such costs eligible to be recouped from incremental property tax revenues, it is necessary to facilitate an internal advance (the "Advance") of funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Jefferson, Iowa, as follows:

Section 1. The City is hereby found to be current on all of its operations and maintenance expenses for the Municipal Waterworks Utility System (the "Water Utility"). Furthermore, the City is hereby found to be up-to-date and in full compliance with the covenants and requirements of all bonds, notes, pledge orders and other obligations to which the Net Revenues of said Water Utility have been pledged. It is hereby found and determined that a surplus of at least \$1,800,000 exists in the Water Revenue Fund. The surplus calculation is shown on Exhibit A hereto.

Section 2. It is hereby directed that an amount not in excess of One Million Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,800,000) be advanced (the "Advance") from the Water Plant Construction Fund (a subfund of the Water Revenue Fund) (the "Source Fund") in order to pay a portion of the costs of the Projects. The Advance shall be repaid to the Source Fund, without interest, out of incremental property tax revenues received with respect to the Urban Renewal Area.

It is intended that the Advance shall be repaid to the Source Fund in one or more installments of principal on or before June 1, 2032, provided, however, that repayment of the Advance is subject to the determination of future City Councils that there are incremental property

tax revenues available for such purpose which have been allocated to or accrued in the Tax Increment Fund relative to the Advance, and the City Council reserves the right to appropriate funds to the repayment of the Advance, or to withhold such appropriation, at its discretion.

- Section 3. A copy of this Resolution shall be filed in the office of the County Auditor of Greene County, Iowa to evidence the Advances. Pursuant to Section 403.19 of the Code of Iowa, the City Clerk is hereby directed to certify the Advances no later than December 1, 2025.
- Section 4. All resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed, to the extent of such conflict.

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Resolution Authorizing Internal Advance for Funding of Urban Renewal Projects in the 2025 Jefferson Redevelopment Urban Renewal Area

WHEREAS, the City of Jefferson, Iowa (the "City"), has previously established the 2025 Jefferson Redevelopment Urban Renewal Area (the "Urban Renewal Area") and has established the 2025 Jefferson Redevelopment Urban Renewal Area Tax Increment Revenue Fund (the "Tax Increment Fund") in connection therewith; and

WHEREAS, the City has authorized certain urban renewal projects (collectively, the "Projects") in the Urban Renewal Area consisting of (1) the Urban Renewal Administration and Professional Support Program; (2) the 2027-2031 Greene County Development Corp. Support Program; and (3) the 2027-2031 Jefferson Matters-Main Street Support Program; and

WHEREAS, certain costs of the Projects have been or will be incurred in connection with the carrying out of such Projects; and

WHEREAS, in order to cover a portion of the costs of the Projects and to make such costs eligible to be recouped from incremental property tax revenues, it is necessary to facilitate an internal advance (the "Advance") of funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Jefferson, Iowa, as follows:

Section 1. The City is hereby found to be current on all of its operations and maintenance expenses for the Municipal Waterworks Utility System (the "Water Utility"). Furthermore, the City is hereby found to be up-to-date and in full compliance with the covenants and requirements of all bonds, notes, pledge orders and other obligations to which the Net Revenues of said Water Utility have been pledged. It is hereby found and determined that a surplus of at least \$75,000 exists in the Water Revenue Fund. The surplus calculation is shown on Exhibit A hereto.

Section 2. It is hereby directed that an amount not in excess of Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000) be advanced (the "Advance") from the Water Plant Construction Fund (a subfund of the Water Revenue Fund) (the "Source Fund") in order to pay a portion of the costs of the Projects. The Advance shall be repaid to the Source Fund, without interest, out of incremental property tax revenues received with respect to the Urban Renewal Area.

It is intended that the Advance shall be repaid to the Source Fund in one or more installments of principal on or before June 1, 2034, provided, however, that repayment of the Advance is subject to the determination of future City Councils that there are incremental property tax revenues available for such purpose which have been allocated to or accrued in the Tax Increment Fund relative to the Advance, and the City Council reserves the right to appropriate funds to the repayment of the Advance, or to withhold such appropriation, at its discretion.

- Section 3. A copy of this Resolution shall be filed in the office of the County Auditor of Greene County, Iowa to evidence the Advances. Pursuant to Section 403.19 of the Code of Iowa, the City Clerk is hereby directed to certify the Advances no later than December 1, 2025.


